SEED MIX FOR NEW 7,000 SF +/- MEADOW AREAS SHALL BE "NEW ENGLAND WILDFLOWER MIX" AS PRODUCED BY NEW ENGLAND WETLAND PLANTS, INC., 820 WEST STREET, AMHERST, MA 01002, PHONE 413-548-8000, WEB WWW.newp.com. APPLY MIX AS RECOMMENDED BY THE MANUFACTURER AT AN APPLICATION RATE OF 23 LBS/ ACRE ON A CLEAN, WEED-FREE SEED BED. APPLY LIGHT LAYER OF WEED-FREE STRAW MULCH AFTER SEEDING.

## PLANTING NOTES

I. ALL PLANT MATERIAL SHALL BE NURSERY GROWN AND CONFORM TO ANLA "AMERICAN STANDARDS FOR NURSERY STOCK". PLANTING AND SEEDING OPERATIONS SHALL BE DONE BETWEEN APRIL I AND JUNE I OR BETWEEN AUGUST 15TH AND OCTOBER 15TH. WHEN WEATHER PERMITS, PLANTING OPERATIONS MAY OCCUR AT THE DISCRETION OF THE LANDSCAPE ARCHITECT (LA).

SHOWY GOLDENROD

2. THE LA RESERVES THE RIGHT TO REJECT ANY AND ALL PLANT MATERIAL WHEN DELIVERED TO THE SITE. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL RECEIVE LA'S APPROVAL OF PLANT MATERIAL PRIOR TO INSTALLATION.

3. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL TAKE CARE TO PREVENT INJURY OR DAMAGE TO PLANTS AND ROOT BALLS IN HANDLING OF PLANTINGS. LA MAY REJECT DAMAGED PLANT MATERIALS. ALL PLASTIC AND NON-ROT BURLAP SHALL BE REMOVED PRIOR TO

4. ALL SUBSTITUTIONS OF PLANT MATERIALS (INCLUDING VARIETY CHANGES) MUST BE APPROVED BY THE LA.

5. IF QUANTITIES INDICATED IN PLANT LIST AND QUANTITIES SHOWN ON DRAWINGS DO NOT MATCH, PROVIDE THE LARGER NUMBER OF QUANTITIES INDICATED. CONTRACTOR SHALL NOTIFY LA OF ANY DISCREPANCIES.

6. LAYOUT PLANT MATERIAL IN THE FIELD FOR APPROVAL OF THE LA PRIOR TO DIGGING. PROVIDE LA WITH 2 DAY'S NOTICE OF INTENT TO INSTALL PLANTINGS.

7. INSTALL TOPSOIL AND SEED AREAS AS NOTED ON PLAN WITH APPROVED SEED MIX. IMMEDIATELY FOLLOWING SEEDING, LIGHTLY APPLY I" OF SALT HAY MULCH. SEED ALL DISTURBED AREAS NOT INDICATED TO RECEIVE OTHER IMPROVEMENTS WITH LAWN SEED

8. SPADE EDGE ALL PLANTING BEDS IN LAWN AREAS.

9. INSTALL 2" DEPTH OF APPROVED SHREDDED BARK MULCH AT ALL PLANTING BEDS AND PITS. SUBMIT MULCH SAMPLE TO LA FOR APPROVAL.

IO. WATER PLANTINGS THOROUGHLY AND IMMEDIATELY AFTER PLANTING. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL, AT HIS/ HER EXPENSE, MAINTAIN ALL PLANTINGS IN A HEALTHY CONDITION UNTIL FINAL ACCEPTANCE BY LA.

AT NO ADDITIONAL COST TO THE OWNER, THE CONTRACTOR SHALL REPLACE ANY PLANTS THAT ARE DEAD OR THAT, IN THE JUDGEMENT OF THE LA, ARE IN UNHEALTHY CONDITION OR HAVE LOST NATURAL SHAPE DUE TO DEAD OR INJURED BRANCHING. ALL

12. RE-SEED ALL AREAS THAT DO NOT SHOW A SATISFACTORY STAND OF LAWN/ MEADOW AFTER 30 DAYS. CONTINUE TO PROVIDE REMEDIAL ACTION UNTIL THE SEEDED AREAS ARE APPROVED BY THE LA.

## TRANSPLANTING NOTES

I. EXISTING TREES TO BE TRANSPLANTED ARE NOTED ON PLAN. VERIFY THE FINAL LOCATION IN THE FIELD WITH THE LANDSCAPE ARCHITECT (LA) PRIOR TO RELOCATING

2. PREPARE FINAL PLANTING PIT PRIOR TO DIGGING EXISTING PLANT MATERIAL. THE DEPTH OF THE EXCAVATED PLANT PITS SHALL BE SUCH THAT THE ROOT BALL SITS ON UNDISTURBED, EXISTING SOIL. IF OVER EXCAVATION ON THE PLANT PIT OCCURS, BACKFILL THE PIT AND COMPACT THE MATERIAL PRIOR TO INSTALLATION OF THE PLANTINGS.

3. ALL PLANTS SHALL BE DUG TO RETAIN AS MANY FIBROUS ROOTS AS POSSIBLE. ENSURE THAT ROOTS ARE SEVERED WITH A CLEAN CUT AND THAT ENDS ARE PROTECTED FROM DAMAGE.

4. A TREE SPADE MAY BE USED TO RELOCATE TREE PLANTINGS. IF A SPADE IS USED, EACH TREE SHALL BE MOVED IN A TIMELY FASHION. ONCE TREE IS EXCAVATED, IMMEDIATELY INSTALL IN PREPARED PLANTING PIT.

5. FOR TREES WHERE A SPADE IS NOT USED, AND FOR ALL OTHER PLANTINGS TO BE RELOCATED, THE PLANT ROOTS SHALL BE BALLED AND BURLAPPED. THE BALL SHALL BE A SOLID BALL OF EARTH SECURELY HELD IN PLACE BY BURLAP AND STOUT ROPE.

6. PRUNE DEAD AND INJURED BRANCHES AND AS DIRECTED BY LANDSCAPE ARCHITECT. 7. AFTER RELOCATION, MULCH PLANTINGS WITH 3" DEPTH SHREDDED BARK MULCH. WATER THOROUGHLY DURING AND AFTER PLANTING OPERATIONS TO STABILIZE PLANTINGS AND AS NECESSARY FOR PLANTINGS TO ESTABLISH.

8. STAKE PLANTINGS AS NECESSARY AND AS DIRECTED BY THE LANDSCAPE

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
